

Operation Encompass

Stockton Sixth Form College participates in Operation Encompass which runs in partnership with Cleveland Police. This new project provides early reporting to the College of any domestic abuse incidents that occur outside of College hours but may have an impact on a student attending College the following day. This information is shared on week days during term time and, when incidents occur on a Friday, Saturday or a Sunday, the police contact the College the following Monday.

The College has a nominated member of College staff who is known as a Key Adult and they liaise with the police. They use information that has been shared with them, in confidence, to ensure that the College is able to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by students, or their families. Information will be shared where it is identified that a young person was present, witnessed or was involved in a domestic abuse incident.
